Understanding Your ALEKS Math Placement Assessment Score

Your ALEKS assessment score indicates your level of mathematics preparation. The table below shows the course you have placed into based on your ALEKS assessment score.

Some colleges, particularly Business, Education, Engineering, Public Health, and Science & Technology, require a specific mathematics sequence. You will receive in-depth advising during orientation regarding these requirements and the mathematics course for which you should register. You can explore program curricula in the Temple Bulletin.

You will receive additional information regarding your course placement and re-assessment opportunities in your Placement Results channel within TUportal.

If you feel you can succeed in a higher-level mathematics course, you may use ALEKS Learning Modules to improve your skills and retake the assessment. It is best to complete the re-assessment before your orientation so that you will have accurate results to guide your registration.

To take a re-assessment you are required to complete five hours of ALEKS Learning Modules and wait 48 hours after the completion of the first assessment before starting the second. For a third assessment, you are required to complete an additional five hours of ALEKS Learning Modules and wait 48 hours after the completion of the second assessment before starting the third.
