Please provide a brief name for this assessment activity.	FIN 5618 Team Presentation
loutcome(s). Provide enough detail	A rubric is used for each assignment to evaluate student competency level on each trait. Communication is assessed using a separate presentation skills rubric.
What were the findings from this assessment?	In FIN 5618 (n=83), 63.9% of students were rated as having a developed competency for business reasoning (goal 2), while 32.5% percent were at the advanced competency level. There were not any students rated at the insufficient competency level. For Oral Communication (Goal 3b), 4.8% performed at the advanced competency level, 88% performed at the developed competency level, and 3.6% performed at the insufficient competency level.

Assessment Activity: FIN 5614 Team Presentation

Please provide a brief name for this assessment activity.	FIN 5614 Team Presentation
Describe the assessment method used to assess the learning outcome(s). Provide enough detail so that we understand the nature of the project.	This is a group presentation evaluated using a rubric. Students within a group all receive the same scores. Communication skills were measured separately from business reasoning using a oral presentation competency rubric.
What were the findings from this assessment?	In Fin 5614 (n=35), students were evaluated on two criteria for business reasoning (goal 2). In the Trade Research category, 48.6% of students performed at the advanced competency level and 51.4% performed at the developed competency level. There were no students who performed at the insufficient competency level. In the Derivative Strategy category, 20% of students performed at the advanced competency level, 71.4% performed at the developed competency level, and 8.6% performed at the insufficient competency level. On Oral Communication (goal 3b), 5.7% of students performed at the advanced competency level, 85.7% performed at the developed competency level, and 8.6% performed at the insufficient competency level.

This is an individual essay graded as either complete or incomplete. Students are required to rewrite the assignment until it is considered satisfactory and accounts for all previous comments and requests for editing. This assignment was a brief paragraph exploring global equity markets requiring research from reputable sources.
What were the findings from this assessment?	All students (n=102) were rated complete. Following revisions, 99% were complete, and 1% were incomplete.

Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) is a national program to evaluate financial markets and models using technology. Students are required to complete it in their first year.
